Proposed Rule Changes as Recommended by the Rules Committee

1. Statutory Business – A quorum for conducting statutory business (called for by the Texas Election Code) shall consist of those members present.

Statutory Business – A quorum for conducting statutory business (required by the Texas Election Code) shall consist of those members present.

2. Article VII

Section 2. The order of business for all regular meetings shall at minimum include:

- 1. Reading and approval of minutes of the last regular meeting and any intervening meetings
- 2. Adoption of Special Orders
- 3. Elections to fill Executive Committee vacancies
- 4. Reports of officers and standing committees
- 5. Reports of special committees
- 6. Special Orders
- 7. Unfinished business and general orders
- 8. New business
- 9. Announcements and introductions

The County Chair may change the order of items above; however, the order chosen must be included in

the call to meeting.

Strike and replace with the following:

Section 2. The order of business for all regular and special meetings shall be published on the County Party Website and included in the call of meeting by the Chair, in accordance with notice requirements.
